Where can the vendor locate the main system and computer components for software and other necessities?

- Inside room 126 near one of the entrances, exact location and specs are covered through building security protocol. However, it'll be easily accessible and in the building for vendor installation.

Is a manned workstation required?

- No and outside the scope of this solicitation.

Will reader license, ID numbers, IP addresses, and other specific information about cyber performance and security be accessible?

- It will be accessible at the time of need during contract performance and installation of the access system. Just know all software and equipment are up to date and the latest versions so it's compatible for all equipment in the statement of work.

Are there any installation parameters?

- Yes! There are multiple building and security specifications that must be adhered to during installation of the system. However, none of them would affect the scope of the contract or require additional work or effort to follow.

General electrical specs?

- This will be a hardwired and low voltage system utilizing the brand name source products in the statement of work. This, although being low voltage, will be a high-profile system and must be installed cleanly for high usage.

Will the system be stand alone or network?

- As of now it's a stand-alone system in accordance with the statement of work. This is currently being evaluated by our in-house USAF personnel and updates will be posted if we obtain them.
