Vendor Questions & Answers (Amendment 4 Hold Notice)

Q1. Why has the solicitation due date been placed on hold?

A1. A protest has been filed with the Government Accountability Office (GAO). In accordance with FAR 33.104, the filing of a GAO protest prevents award of a contract and thus the solicitation due date is stayed which pauses any and all actions as related to the solicitation, per amendment 4.

Q2. How long will the solicitation be on hold?

A2. The solicitation will remain on hold until the GAO issues a decision or the protest is otherwise resolved. At that time, the Bureau of Prisons will issue an amendment with updated instructions and deadlines.

Q3. Can the Government provide further details about the protest?

A3. The protest was filed at GAO, and upon request, and according to FAR 33.104(a), an interested party may request a copy of the redacted protest from BOP or communicate directly with GAO regarding the protest.

Q4. What should offerors do in the meantime?

A4. Offerors are encouraged to monitor SAM.gov regularly for future amendments and updates from the Bureau of Prisons.
