Statement of Work (SOW)

Annual Renewal of SuperSMITH(r) Software License and Maintenance

For the AB412 Structural Integrity Branch

A. Background

The AB412 branch provides structural analysis dispositions related to all Naval Propulsion and Power engine platforms. The Structure Integrity Branch (AB41200) actively supports multiple PMAs for FEA structural analysis, life management and risk assessments to support ongoing engineering efforts. In support of risk management, AB412 requires the use of advanced statistical modelling software and is requesting an upgrade to the existing SuperSMITH(r) site license.

B. Technical Requirements

The contractor shall provide one (1) SuperSMITH(r) Software Site License renewal. The renewal shall meet the following minimum technical requirements:

1. **Software Version:** The license shall be for the most current version of the software, but no older than version 6.X.
2. **License Term:** The license shall be valid for the entire Period of Performance specified in this Statement of Work.
3. **Maintenance:** The renewal shall include one year of software maintenance, which must provide access to all version upgrades, minor updates, and security patches released during the Period of Performance.
4. **Support:** The renewal shall include one year of standard technical support, available via email or phone during normal business hours, to assist government users with software-related issues.

C. License Delivery

The contractor shall deliver a permanent, non-temporary software license key and all necessary installation media/files to the Government Technical Point of Contact (TPOC) within 30 days of contract award. A temporary or time-limited license is not acceptable to meet this requirement.

D. Period of Performance

The period of performance for the software license and its associated maintenance and support shall be from 22 September 2026 to 21 September 2027.

WIDE AREA WORKFLOW PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS (JAN 2023)

(a) *Definitions.* As used in this clause-

"Department of Defense Activity Address Code (DoDAAC)" is a six position code that uniquely identifies a unit, activity, or organization.

"Document type" means the type of payment request or receiving report available for creation in Wide Area WorkFlow (WAWF).

"Local processing office (LPO)" is the office responsible for payment certification when payment certification is done external to the entitlement system.

"Payment request" and "receiving report" are defined in the clause at 252.232-7003, Electronic Submission of Payment Requests and Receiving Reports.

REPRESENTATION BY CORPORATIONS REGARDING DELINQUENT TAX LIABILITY OR A FELONY CONVICTION UNDER ANY FEDERAL LAW (FEB 2026) (DEVIATION 2026-00038)

(a) The Government will not enter into a contract with any corporation that-

PROHIBITION ON THE ACQUISITION OF COVERED DEFENSE TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT OR SERVICES-REPRESENTATION (MAY 2021)

The Offeror is not required to complete the representation in this provision if the Offeror has represented in the provision at 252.204-7016, Covered Defense Telecommunications Equipment or Services-Representation, that it "does not provide covered defense telecommunications equipment or services as a part of its offered products or services to the Government in the performance of any contract, subcontract, or other contractual instrument."

(a) *Definitions.* "Covered defense telecommunications equipment or services," "covered mission," "critical technology," and "substantial or essential component," as used in this provision, have the meanings given in the 252.204-7018 clause, Prohibition on the Acquisition of Covered Defense Telecommunications Equipment or Services, of this solicitation.

(b) *Prohibition.* Section 1656 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2018 (Pub. L. 115-91) prohibits agencies from procuring or obtaining, or extending or renewing a contract to procure or obtain, any equipment, system, or service to carry out covered missions that uses covered defense telecommunications equipment or services as a substantial or essential component of any system, or as critical technology as part of any system.
