This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial products prepared in accordance with FAR 12.6, Streamlined Procedures for Evaluation and Solicitation for Commercial Products and Commercial Services, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice and RFO FAR 12.201, Simplified Procedures. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; quotations are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued. The solicitation number is HT940626QE119. The solicitation is issued as a Request for Quotation (RFQ) via SAM.gov. Provisions and clauses in effect through Federal Acquisition Circular 2023-05 (published 08 August 2023) are incorporated. There is no set-aside used for this action. The associated North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS) code for this procurement is 811210, with a small business size standard of \$34M.

The Naval Medical Center Portsmouth (NMCP) The Cardiac Cath Lab at Naval Medical Center Portsmouth, VA has a requirement for a maintenance and service plan for the EnSite X Electrophysiology Mapping System used in the diagnosis and treatment of cardiac arrhythmia. The contractor shall provide all personnel, equipment, supplies, facilities, transportation, tools, materials, supervision, and other items and non-personal services necessary to perform EnSite X Electrophysiology Mapping System Service as defined in this Performance Work Statement (PWS). Continuous system availability and functionality are essential to support patient care and procedural efficiency in the EP/Cath Lab. An annual service contract is required to support the EnSite X Electrophysiology Mapping System located within the Cardiac Cath Lab. Services include preventive maintenance, corrective maintenance, software updates and upgrades, technical support, and system optimization. The contractor shall ensure the system remains fully operational and compliant with Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) standards. This solicitation will result in one (1) firm fixed price purchase order.

WIDE AREA WORKFLOW PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS (JAN 2023)

(a) *Definitions.* As used in this clause-

"Department of Defense Activity Address Code (DoDAAC)" is a six position code that uniquely identifies a unit, activity, or organization.

"Document type" means the type of payment request or receiving report available for creation in Wide Area WorkFlow (WAWF).

"Local processing office (LPO)" is the office responsible for payment certification when payment certification is done external to the entitlement system.

"Payment request" and "receiving report" are defined in the clause at 252.232-7003, Electronic Submission of Payment Requests and Receiving Reports.

52.229-11 Tax on Certain Foreign Procurements-Notice and Representation. (Deviation 2026-O0038) (Feb 2026)

TAX ON CERTAIN FOREIGN PROCUREMENTS-NOTICE AND REPRESENTATION (FEB 2026) (DEVIATION 2026-O0038)

(a) *Definitions.* As used in this provision-

Foreign person means any person other than a United States person.

Specified Federal procurement payment means any payment made pursuant to a contract with a foreign contracting party that is for goods, manufactured or produced, or services provided in a foreign country that is not a party to an international procurement agreement with the United States. For purposes of the prior sentence, a foreign country does not include an outlying area of the United States.

United States person as defined in 26 U.S.C. 7701(a)(30) means

- (1) A citizen or resident of the United States;
- (2) A domestic partnership;
- (3) A domestic corporation;
- (4) Any estate (other than a foreign estate, within the meaning of 26 U.S.C. 701(a)(31)); and
- (5) Any trust if-
 - (i) A court within the United States is able to exercise primary supervision over the administration of the trust; and
 - (ii) One or more United States persons have the authority to control all substantial decisions of the trust.

(b) Unless exempted, there is a 2 percent tax of the amount of a specified Federal procurement payment on any foreign person receiving such payment. See 26 U.S.C. 5000C and its implementing regulations at 26 CFR 1.5000C-1 through 1.5000C-7.

(c) Exemptions from withholding under this provision are described at 26 CFR 1.5000C-1(d)(5) through (7). The Offeror may claim an exemption from the withholding by using the Department of the Treasury Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Form W-14, Certificate of Foreign Contracting Party Receiving Federal Procurement Payments, available at www.irs.gov/w14. Any exemption claimed and self-certified on the IRS Form W-14 is subject to audit by the IRS. Any disputes regarding the imposition and collection of the 26 U.S.C. 5000C tax are adjudicated by the IRS as the 26 U.S.C. 5000C tax is a tax matter, not a contract issue. The IRS Form W-14 is provided to the acquiring agency rather than to the IRS.

(d) For purposes of withholding under 26 U.S.C. 5000C, the Offeror represents that

(d) *Representation.* If in its annual representations and certifications in SAM the Offeror has represented in paragraph (c) of the provision at 252.204-7016, Covered Defense Telecommunications Equipment or Services-Representation, that it "does" provide covered defense telecommunications equipment or services as a part of its offered products or services to the Government in the performance of any contract, subcontract, or other contractual instrument, then the Offeror shall complete the following additional representation:

(3) For services, the entity providing the covered defense telecommunications services (include entity name, unique entity identifier, and Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) code, if known).

(4) For equipment, the entity that produced or provided the covered defense telecommunications equipment (include entity name, unique entity identifier, CAGE code, and whether the entity was the OEM or a distributor, if known).
