Evaluation Criteria

RFO Provision 52.212-2, Evaluation -- Commercial Products and Services, applies to this acquisition. As prescribed in RFO 12.205(a)(2), the following addendum is provided for this solicitation and hereby amends any language therein:

(a) The Government will award a contract resulting from this solicitation to the responsible offeror whose quote conforming to the solicitation will be most advantageous to the Government, price and other factors considered. The following factors shall be used to evaluate quotes:

- Price

- Technical acceptability
 - o See Instructions to Offerors, number 6 for what information is necessary to be determined technically acceptable.

(b) The Government will use a Lowest Price Technically Acceptable assessment for the award decision. The Government seeks to award a contract to the Contractor whose proposal represents the Lowest Price Technically Acceptable outcome with greatest overall benefit in the Government's estimation.

(c) A written notice of award or acceptance of a quote mailed or otherwise furnished to the successful offeror within the time for acceptance specified in the quote, shall result in a binding contract without further action by either party. Before the quote's specified expiration time, the Government may accept a quote (or part of quote), whether or not there are negotiations after its receipt, unless a written notice of withdrawal is received before award.
