

1. Attachment 7 (Environmental Specifications 2026) is protected by Microsoft Information Rights Management and cannot be opened with standard PDF readers. Could you please provide an accessible copy?

2. Two versions of Attachment 3 (Clauses and Provisions) were included in the solicitation package - one titled "Clauses_and_Provisions.pdf" and one titled "Clauses_and_Provisions_Updated.pdf." The two differ in that clause 52.232-18 (Availability of Funds) appears in the original but not the updated version. Please confirm which version is authoritative for quoting purposes.

Per amendment 1, this clause was removed. The updated Clauses take precedence.

3. The PWS (Attachment 5, Section 1.5) and Appendix A reference a mix of fixed and PTZ (Pan-Tilt-Zoom) cameras, but the equipment list in Appendix A.2 lists only fixed-mount cameras, and the Salient Characteristics document (Attachment 8) states the 8MP cameras have a locked (fixed) direction. Please confirm whether PTZ cameras are required, and if so, in what quantity and locations.

We are requesting 3 cameras with 360 degree and PTZ capability. We are requesting 11 fixed direction cameras. All camera locations will be identified on the new map attachment to the PWS.

4. Appendix A of the PWS specifies a minimum 18-hour UPS battery runtime, while the Salient Characteristics document states an 8-hour runtime. Please confirm which specification is controlling.

8-hour

5. Are floor plans or maps available showing the camera, server, and viewing station locations?

Map will be added to the PWS.

6. Should we assume the existing camera cabling will be reused? If not, should new cabling be included in our quote?

Yes, all new cabling will be needed and included in quote.

7. For the three decoders and viewing station, will the existing monitors/displays be reused?

No, we have acquired new Monitors and TVs that will have HDMI ports. Monitoring devices will be shown on map.

8. Will the new system use the existing patch panels and network switches, or should any additional network equipment be included in our quote?
