PART I- THE SCHEDULE

Amend 001: SKU item changed to PBBB-MIU-BLK/RD-72-R-A-V.

Amend 002: Delivery changed to within **120** days after Contract Award and added FAR 52.225-1, Buy American—Supplies.

This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial products or commercial services prepared in accordance with Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) Part 12 and has incorporated provisions and clauses that are in effect through Federal Acquisition Circular (FAC) 2026-01 dated 03/13/2026. This announcement constitutes the only Solicitation; quotations are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued.

The solicitation number 26ART2629 is issued as a Request for Quotation (RFQ) to provide Punching Bags for FLETC, located in Artesia, New Mexico.

The associated North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS) code for this procurement is 339920 (Sporting and Athletic Goods Manufacturing). This requirement is a Small Business Set-Aside, and only qualified offerors may submit quotes.

1.0 Background

FLETC has a requirement to procure 100 new freestanding punching bags to support physical conditioning and defensive tactics training. This Solicitation seeks quotes for equipment that meets or exceeds the specifications of the ProBoxingSupplies punching bag (SKU: PBBB-MIU-BLK/RD-72-R-A-V). The quote shall include all costs for the punching bags and shipping/freight charges to the facility.

2.0 Instructions

Vendors are reminded to carefully review the salient characteristics, terms, and conditions of this RFQ and submit quotes that meet these standards. Providing complete information is solely the responsibility of the vendor. FLETC is not required to request missing or additional information from vendors after the submission deadline. Quotes that do not meet the salient characteristics, terms, and conditions of this RFQ will not be considered for award.

Quotations must be submitted electronically via email to the Contracting Officer (CO) and Contract Specialist (CS) no later than 9/18/2026 at 1100 am MDT.

2.1 Quotations must include:

- RFQ Number
- Price proposal utilizing Schedule of Pricing CLIN
- Full product specifications and details, including pictures/images of the proposed item
- Manufacturer's warranty information
- Unique Entity Identification number (UEI)

3.0 Schedule of Supply

The Contractor shall provide a firm-fixed-price quote for the following Contract Line-Item Numbers (CLINs):

- Minimum Specification:
 - Height & Stature: 72 inches (6 feet) tall.
 - Weight Profile: Approximately 110 lbs.
 - Base Design: Weighted, low-profile, sand-filled base designed to rebound instantly to its vertical position.
 - Striking Surface: 14" diameter striking area constructed with high-density, impact-absorbing foam.
 - Cover Material: Heavy-duty, military-grade textured vinyl (Rip-Stop material).
 - Brand Name or Equal: ProBoxingSupplies
 - SKU: PBBB-MIU-BLK/RD-72-R-A-V

4.0 Delivery/Performance

- Delivery is required within 120 days after Contract Award.
- Shipping shall not be priced separately (NSP). Shipping Cost shall be included in the cost of each CLIN.
- It is requested that all line items be delivered in approximately 2 shipments or less.

5.0 Evaluation Criteria

Award will be made to the responsible offeror whose quotation represents the Lowest Price Technically Acceptable (LPTA) quote. Technical acceptability will be determined on a pass/fail basis, by assessing whether the proposed product meets all the minimum specifications listed in Section 3.0.
