

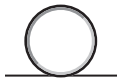

SOLE SOURCE: Item is available from only one vendor. Item is one-of-a-kind and is not sold through distributors. Manufacturer is sole distributor.



SOLE BRAND: Various vendors can supply the specified model and brand and competitive bids will be solicited for the requested brand only.

1. What are the unique performance features of the product or brand requested that are not available in any other product or brand. (Services: What are the unique qualifications that this vendor possesses?)

These items are on the FEMA TRM and which is the vehicle that FEMA uses to approve hardware for purchase. We can only purchase hardware that is approved and listed on the TRM. This is a brand-name requirement. The Government is not limiting competition to a single vendor. Multiple authorized resellers and distributors may provide the required brand-name items and competition.

2. Why are these unique features required? (Services: Why are these unique qualifications necessary?)

We are not allowed to purchase hardware not on the TRM.
