Pre-Proposal Project Overview and Site Visit

**August 18, 2026, at 2 p.m. – meet in front of the Albright Visitor Center in Mammoth
and**

August 19, 2026, at 9 a.m. – meet in front of the Canyon Visitor Education Center

August 18 directions

From Gardiner: Follow the Old Gardiner Road (the only road beyond the park entrance gate) to the intersection immediately north of the Mammoth administration area. Follow yellow line on map below. Allow 15 minutes once through the park gate.

From West Yellowstone: Drive through the park entrance gate. Turn left at Madison Junction. Go straight at Norris Junction. Follow blue line to intersection immediately north of the Mammoth administration area once you've reached Mammoth. Allow 2 hours once through the park gate.

Parking will be hard to find, so arrive early. Meet in front of the Albright Visitor Center at 3 p.m. DSC staff will greet participants and lead the group into the administration building for a project overview. Then, DSC will lead a caravan to the Mammoth construction area so prospective bidders can view the project site.



August 19 directions

Follow road maps to Canyon Village. Google Maps says it is a 1-hour, 15-minute drive from Gardiner or a 1-hour, 10-minute drive from West Yellowstone. Once you arrive at the Canyon intersection, follow the yellow line on the map below to the Canyon Visitor Education Center. DSC staff will meet participants there at 9 a.m. and lead a tour to the Canyon and Northeast Entrance project sites.



Actual driving times are hard to predict, so DSC staff will wait a reasonable amount of time for interested Offerors who have signed up for the site visit in advance. Cell phone coverage is spotty, but participants are urged to call 303-619-3620 or 907-738-1782 if it appears they will arrive late.

9:15 a.m.: Tour the Canyon project site. DSC staff will lead a caravan of vehicles to Canyon Government Area project site. Most of the tour will be on or near paved roads.

10:30 a.m.: Leave the Canyon project site, heading to the Northeast Entrance. Plan on eating in the car, as this will be a 2-hour drive.

12:30 p.m.: DSC staff will lead a tour of the Northeast Entrance project site. Most of the tour will be on or near paved roads.
