WIDE AREA WORKFLOW PAYMENT INSTRUCTIONS (JAN 2023)

(a) *Definitions.* As used in this clause-

"Department of Defense Activity Address Code (DoDAAC)" is a six position code that uniquely identifies a unit, activity, or organization.

"Document type" means the type of payment request or receiving report available for creation in Wide Area WorkFlow (WAWF).

1. The contractor shall provide all of the following information and submitted along with its offer. Any missing information can deem your offer unresponsive and will not be evaluated.

a) A price quote to complete the cable television installation as well as the subscription service for the base year and all option periods. This includes but is not limited to all costs related to transportation, labor, and materials. Contractor shall use "Attachment 4 - Pricing Workbook."

b) Installation approach: The offeror shall present relevant information articulating the offeror's proposed approach to meeting the PWS requirements. This section shall clearly demonstrate the offeror's understanding by providing a clear description of the proposed approach to performing the work. The offeror's description should include a clear description of all processes and procedures employed. This section shall not include any pricing data. The offeror's quote information will be evaluated to assess the risk that the offeror will timely meet contract requirements.

c) The offeror must confirm and briefly explain how they will meet the physical and logical delivery of twelve (12) continuous, HD, unencrypted IP streams directly to the Government-owned Haivision System. The narrative must address:

1) Signal Acquisition & Decryption:

- Identify the commercial signal source provider (e.g., DirecTV, DISH Network, or other commercial satellite/cable feeds).
- State the hardware/methodology (e.g., commercial integrated receiver-decoders, decryption blades, IP gateways) that will be used to fully decrypt the commercial signals at the contractor's headend prior to physical handoff.
- Prohibition of Encryption: Explicitly confirm that the streams delivered to the Government's Media Switch will contain NO digital rights management (DRM) or proprietary commercial encryptions (including Pro:Idiom, Verimatrix, or BISS).
- Cable television package breakdown to include the list of channels (Not to exceed 12 channels)

2) Licensing: Confirm that all licensing, retransmission rights, copyright, and institutional broadcast fees are fully included in the firm-fixed-price.

Addendum to 52.212-2 Evaluation--Commercial Products and Commercial Services.

1. The Government will award a contract resulting from this RFQ to the responsible vendor whose quote conforming to the RFQ will be most advantageous to the Government, price and other factors considered. The following factors shall be used to evaluate quotes:

- a) Price
- b) Technical Acceptability- Proposals will first be reviewed for completeness and conformance to the instructions to offerors. Determination will be made based on the contractor's ability to meet the requirements listed in the Performance Work Statement. This determination will be made solely on the information provided in the offeror's proposal
- c) Past Performance - Evaluated on a "Pass/Fail" basis. Determination will be made based on the information retrieved from Contractor Performance Assessment Reporting System (CPARS). If there is any performance rating below "satisfactory" the evaluation will be considered as fail and the offeror will not be considered for award. In the case of an offeror without a record of past performance or for whom information on past performance is not available, the offeror may not be evaluated favorably or unfavorably on past performance.
