**JUSTIFICATION AND APPROVAL
FOR USE OF OTHER THAN FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION**

1. Contracting Activity.

The Naval Sea Systems Command, Pearl Harbor Naval Shipyard & Intermediate Maintenance Facility (PHNSY & IMF) Contracts Division, Code 410.

2. Description of the Action Being Approved.

Award a sole source contract for the maintenance, repair, and overhaul of Ship's Service Turbine Generator (SSTG) No. 1 and No. 2 to the Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM), Northrop Grumman Marine Systems (NG), in support of a Virginia Class submarine.

3. Description of Supplies/Services.

a. The supply to be acquired is to provide maintenance, repair, and overhaul of the SSTG No.1 and No.2 aboard a Virginia-Class submarine in accordance with work package HIRMC-502-26.

b. Government IGE: \$8,012,197.41

c. FY-26, OM&N

d. Period of performance: 31 August 2026 - 31 August 2028 or until work is completed

The Government's minimum needs have been verified by the certifying technical and requirements personnel.

4. Statutory Authority Permitting Other Than Full and Open Competition.

10 U.S.C. 3204(a)(1), Only one responsible source and no other supplies or services will satisfy agency requirements.

5. Rationale Justifying Use of Cited Statutory Authority.

Northrop Grumman has developed proprietary processes and possess specialized tooling and proprietary software to support the maintenance, repair and overhaul of turbine high pressure (THP) bearing assembly, THP Radial Rotor, Turbine Low Pressure (TLP) Bearing Assembly, Generator Coupling End (GCE), Bearing Assembly, Turbine to Generator Coupling, Thrust Rotor, and inboard and outboard Thrust Stator Assemblies of the #1 & #2 Ship Service Turbine Generator (SSTG) aboard Virginia Class submarines. Northrop does not disclose their proprietary processes or specialized tooling with any other party including the Government. However, the proprietary processes and specialized tooling Northrop Grumman possesses are necessary to complete the maintenance, repair, and overhaul with satisfactory results as verified by PHNSY Engineering & Planning Department (EPD). Therefore, Northrop Grumman, the OEM, is the only vendor that can satisfy the Government's requirement.

6. Description of Efforts Made to Solicit Offers from as Many Offerors as Practicable.

This current requirement is nearly identical to previous historical requirements. Results of prior and current market research utilizing sources sought synopses are displayed on the table above. Prior market research demonstrated only one interested party responded on previous contract N32253-24-C-0008. Current market research resulted in a separate interested party responding to the sources sought.

The current sources sought notice was posted from 16 December 2025 – 30 December 2025 resulted in one interested party submitting a capabilities statement. The local interested party stated in their capabilities statement that they are capable of integrating and hosting OEM personnel but not directly capable of performing any SSTG repairs.

In consideration of this capability statement, the Contract Specialist further inquired with the OEM on whether they perform as a subcontractor for SSTG type work. The OEM replied via email on 23 January 2026 and verbally on 27 January 2026 verifying that they do not perform as a subcontractor and the only subcontracting existing arrangement they have is for larger, new hull construction. The OEM also stated that for all SSTG type work, it does not perform as a subcontractor. As such, it is determined that the interested party is not technically capable of performing the work or providing for the OEM technical representative requirements as required by HIRMC-502-26.

As the one interested party was found to be technically incapable of performing the work, the Government concludes that there is only one responsible source that can perform this requirement.

7. Determination of Fair and Reasonable Cost.

The Contracting Officer will ensure the anticipated cost to the Government for the supplies/service for this requirement covered by this J&A will be fair and reasonable. The Contracting Officer's determination of fair and reasonable price will be based on price and cost analyses in accordance with FAR 15.404-1 Proposal Analysis techniques.

Similar quantities of this requirement have been purchased routinely from this vendor in the past, and pricing information was received on those past procurements. The information from historical contracts provide sufficient data to support a fair and reasonable determination for this procurement.

8. Actions to Remove Barriers to Future Competition.

For the reasons set forth above, PHNSY & IMF Code 410 has no plans at this time to compete future contracts for the types of supplies/services covered by this document. Sources sought will be conducted for future requirements of this type and if another potential source emerges, PHNSY & IMF Code 410 will assess whether competition for future requirements is feasible.
